

Kunming (Yunnan province)



- Capital city of Yunnan province, with a total population of 6.7 million and an area of 21,473km2
- 2017, the city' s GDP totaled 485.8 billion RMB, GDP per capita at 10,600 USD. It has a municipal budget at 56 billion RMB.
- Main industries:
 - Machinery, metal processing and tobacco, tourism
 - Also also one of the biggest exhibition centers in China
- > Interested sector for cooperation with EU cities
 - Industry cooperation: new-generation IT, bio-medicine, work with innovation centers/R&D centers in EU to promote technology transfer
 - International exhibitions and conferences, tourism, health care
 - Smart and ecological city development

Haikou (Hainan province)




- Capital city of Hainan province, political, economic, cultural and transportation center of the province.
- Total population of of 2.27 million and an area of 2305 km2
- In 2017, the city' s GDP totaled 139 billion RMB, GDP per capita at 9728 USD. It has a municipal budget at 39 billion RMB.
- Main industries: Agriculture, fishery, machinery, international conference & exhibition, health and tourism, etc.
- Recent policy boost: Free Trade Port
- > Interested sector for cooperation with EU cities
 - Industry cooperation: machinery and high-tech sectors
 - International exhibitions and conferences: ocean-economy related topics
 - Vocational education exchange and cooperation with EU countries
 - Ecological protection
 - High-end medical care and tourism

Liuzhou (Guangxi province)




- Liuzhou is the second largest city and the most important industrial city of Guangxi province. Population of 4 million, an area of 18,600 km2, and urbanization rate at 64%
- In 2017, the city' s GDP totaled 275.6 billion RMB, and GDP per capita at 11,055 USD. The city has a municipal budget at 40 billion RMB in 2017.
- Main industries include automotive (one of the five automotive cities in China), machinery, metal processing, medical sectors and chemical industry.
- Interested sector for cooperation with EU cities
 - Industry cooperation: IT, new materials, new energy, modern logistics. Smart equipment, automobile
 - Renewable energy and environment protection
 - International education and training
 - Sino-EU Strategic Cooperation Demonstration Zone in Liudong New District: technology transfer and low-carbon ecological city development

Yantai (Shandong province)



- Yantai is the second largest industrial city in Shandong province, next to Qingdao.
- > Population of 7 million, and a total land area of 13,756 km2.
- In 2017, the city' s GDP totaled 734 billion RMB, GDP per capita at 14812 USD. It has a municipal budget of 57 billion RMB.
- Main industries: machinery, equipment, automobiles and spare parts, electronics and information, etc. Emerging industries include new materials, high-end equipment, etc.
- Interested sector for cooperation with EU cities
 - Industry cooperation: automobile, new materials, ICT, machinery and high-tech manufacturing
 - Port logistics and trade, blue economy (ocean-related industries)
 - Circular economy, renewable energy and environment protection
 - International education

Weinan (Shaanxi province)




- Weinan is the 2nd biggest city of Shaanxi province in terms of population. It has a total population of 5.8 million and an area of 13,134 km2
- In 2017, the city' s GDP totaled 165.7 billion RMB, GDP per capita at 4,877 USD. It has a municipal budget of 7.2 billion RMB.
- Important agricultural base in China.
- Main industries: metal and food processing, energy and chemical industry.
 - Interested sector for cooperation with EU cities
 - Industry cooperation: high-end manufacturing and high-tech sectors
 - Sustainable agriculture
 - Clean energy and new-energy vehicles
 - International education
