- A national central city, a global metropolis of technological, educational, cultural, transportation and business



- A few bullet points on the temprory effects of the current Covid19 crisis:
- Health risks and threats: 406 cases in Guangzhou in total, 68 in hospital, dozens of imported cases



- Impact on local economy and business development:
- Decreased demand for normal products/services, staff shortage, shortage of supplies, especially the protection products, the annual Canton Fair postponed...
- Inconvenience in daily life and work:
- Many facilities such as schools, restaurants still can not be operated normally.
