- 320.000 Inhabitants
- Many large companies (production): Daimler, Roche, John Deere
- COVID-19 Figures of yesterday (26.03.):
 - Germany: 42.000 (Deaths: 253)
 - Baden-Wuerttemberg: 8.161 (Deaths: 70)
 - Mannheim: 179
- Complete shut-down (schools, kindergarden, shops (except for food etc)



Part 3 – Challenges, lessons learnt & recommendations

- Cities have to get access to Corona Response Investment Initiative (CRII) soon
- Local investment fund to support innovative start-ups which have financial difficulties caused by the CORONA-Crisis
- Can IUC support the transport of goods from China to European Cities?
- Needed Items of Mannheim:
 - surgical face mask (500.000 Pieces)
 - FFP2-Mask with and without valve (300.000 Pieces)
 - FFP3-Mask (15.000 Pieces)
 - Disposable gloves (300.000 pairs)
 - Surgical Caps (2.000 pieces)
 - surgical gowns (25.000 Pieces)
 - disposable suits (40.000 Pieces)
