
Part 1 - General Description

- 179 municipalities
- 2.8 million inhabitants
- EUR 150 billion GDP (2017)
- Head offices of Bosch, Daimler, Porsche, Festo

Effects of the current Covid19 crisis

- 1.988 people infected in Stuttgart Region (26 March, RKI)
- 36.508 people infected in Germany (26 March, RKI)
- Deaths: 12 (Stuttgart Region), 198 (Germany)
- Shutdown of public life and parts of the economy

Part 3 – Challenges, lessons learnt & recommendations

- Dependent on international exchange and cooperation (workers, supply chains, trade, etc.)
- New work culture in white collar jobs (home office)
- Due to less passengers: reduced frequency of public transport → crowded trains, buses
- Solidarity within society and among countries (e.g. patients from France that are treated in hospitals in Baden-Württemberg)
