Indonesia Cities – UCLG ASPAC

- As of 20 March 2020, the Government of the Republic of Indonesia has reported 450 confirmed cases and 38 deaths related to COVID-19
- The COVID-19 spread to more than 17 provinces since the first case was found in Jakarta on 2 March.
- Jakarta is home to more than 10 million population and is the nation's capital with nearly 60 percent of business, trade, and transportation centre.
- On 14 March, the President of Indonesia declared the state of emergency status for 14 days and established the special taskforce for COVID-19 pandemic at national level.
- The Governor of Jakarta decided to close the schools for 14 days starting 16 March to 2 April and imposed the work from home for government officers (social distancing) until further notice
