Penampang, Malaysia

- Penampang District is located in Sabah's West Coast Division, with Penampang Town as its capital, where it functions essentially as a suburb of Kota Kinabalu.
- District covers only 425 square kilometers.
- 121,934 inhabitans (2010 census)
