江苏省人民政府于 2016 年 6 月 27 日向我会报送了《江苏省人民政府关于申请举办 2021 世界园艺博览会的函》（苏政函〔2016〕49 号）和扬州市人民政府《2021 世界园艺博览会举办方案》，中国花卉协会组织国内专家组和国际园艺生产者协会（英文简称 AIPH）专家组进行了实地考察，并于 8 月 22 日，由国家林业局致函外交部、商务部、中国贸促会征求意见（《国家林业局办公室关于推荐扬州市申办 2021 年世界园艺博览会（B 类）征求意见的函》（办函造字〔2016〕444 号），一致认为扬州市具备举办世界园艺博览会的良好基础和条件。

办调查表。2016 年 9 月 28 日，中国花卉协会与扬州市有关部门共同组成中国申办代表团在土耳其安塔利亚召开的第 68 届 AIPH 年会上，进行了申办陈述。9 月 30 日，经 AIPH 全体会议表决一致通过。

2017 年 2 月 9 日，AIPH 主席伯纳德·欧斯特罗姆致函中国花卉协会会长江泽慧，表明：扬州市申请举办 2021 年世界园艺博览会，已按规定完成实地考察、申办陈述和交纳 10 万欧元保证金等程序，AIPH 正式批准扬州市举办 2021 年世界园艺博览会（B 类），举办时间为 2021 年 4 月至 10 月。

Expo Site and Surrounding Environment

The site of International Horticultural Exposition 2021 Yangzhou is located at the core area of Zaolinwan Tourist Resort, covering 220 hectares. As a renowned livable city, Yangzhou has won the UN Habitat Scroll of Honor for its outstanding ecological system, plus National Garden City and National Forest City. Forestation rate of the urban area is about 43.71%.

Expo 2021 Yangzhou sits in the Zaolinwan Tourist Resort, covering 68 square kilometers. Blessed with three mountains, five lakes, two springs and one river, the Resort is recognized as the largest hill ecological park in the Eastern regions of China, the largest ecological center in Yangzhou, and a backyard garden of Nanjing Metropolitan Circle. Zaolinwan enjoys diverse landforms ranging from low hills, wetlands, lakes to pastoral areas and forests. Moreover, there are a variety of flowers, green tea, forest fruit, and Chinese herbal medicines, with its forest green coverage rate reaching over 60%.



CLIMATE

Zaolinwan area is located in the subtropical monsoon climate zone, which enjoys warm and moist climate, four distinct seasons and bountiful rains. The prevailing winds blow across this area from the southeast.

Mean annual temperature: 14~15.4℃;
Average January temperature: -1~1.8℃;
Extreme low temperature: -8.7~-11.5℃;
Annual mean precipitation: 910~1090mm;
Annual mean sunshine duration: approx. 2176 hours;
Annual frost-free period: 221 days.

TOPOGRAPHY

Zaolinwan area: undulations of the ridge and hills; Ground elevation: 50m in the northwest; 20m in the southeast. General terrain: low in the southeast and high in the northwest.

HYDROLOGY

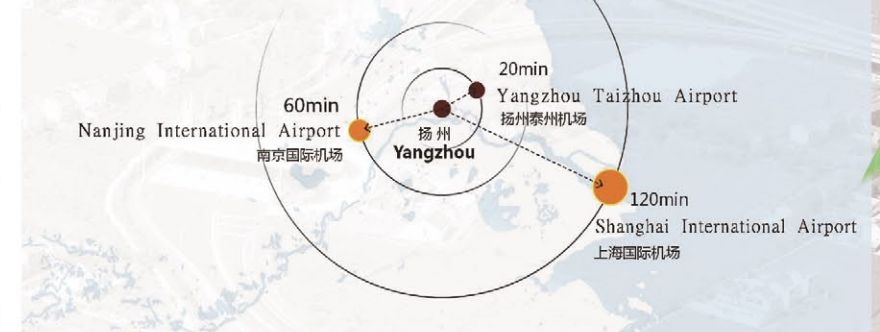
In the domain of Zaolinwan, there are 7 large-scale reservoirs; Xupu River runs through the whole area from north side of Tongshan Hill to the Yangtze River; the area enjoys abundant groundwater resources with high water and quality mineral water under the ground near Tongshan Hill.

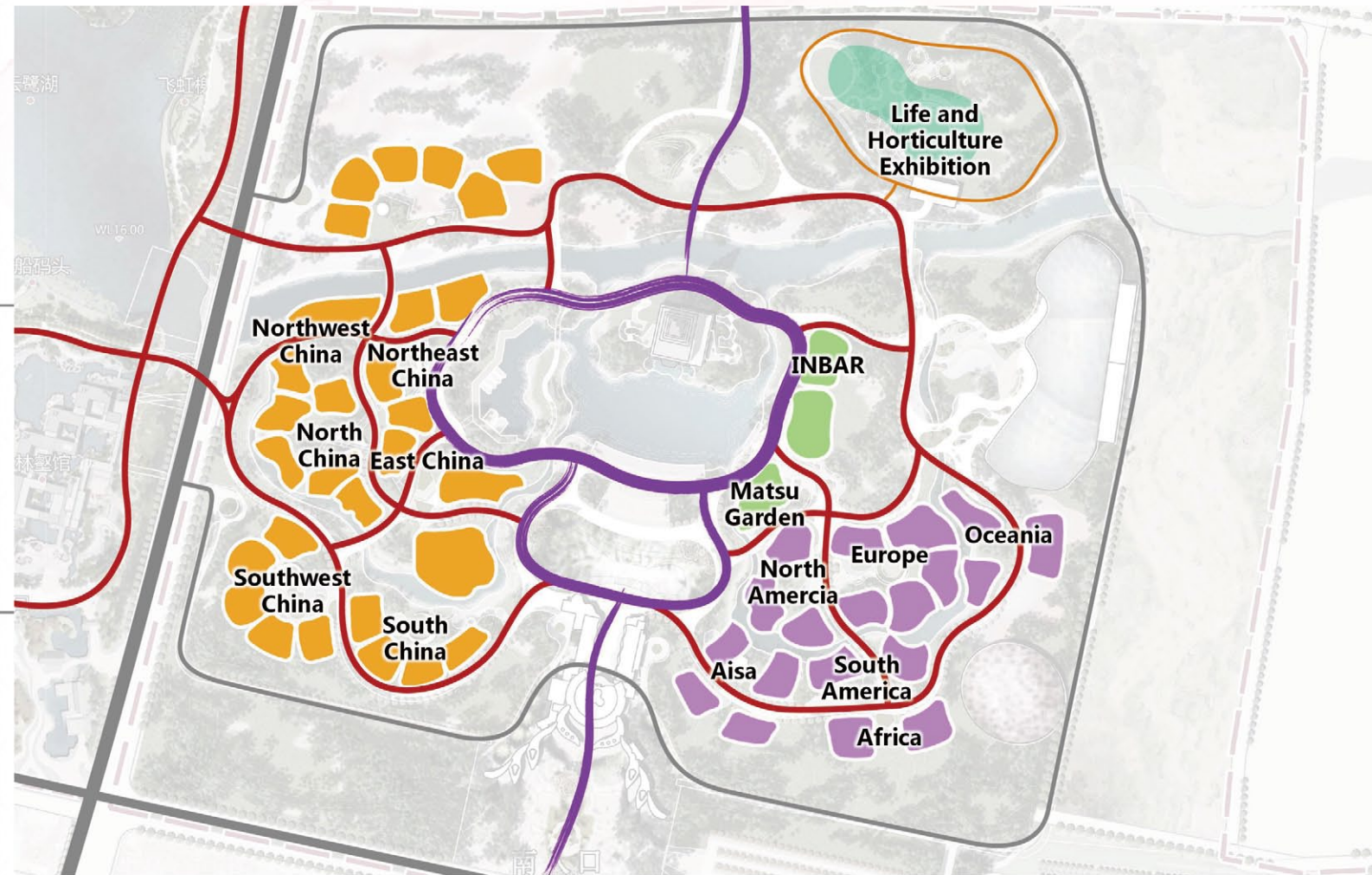

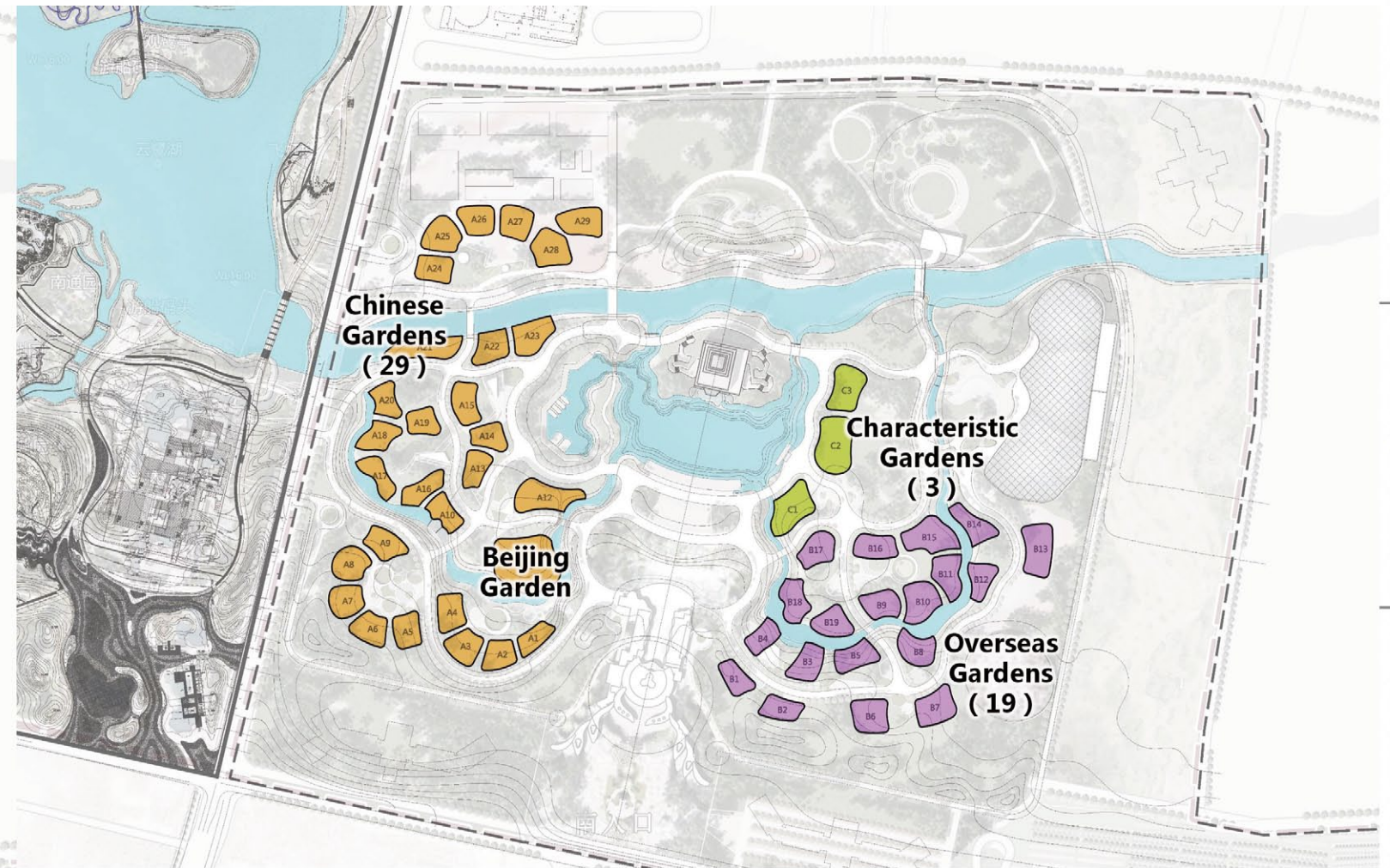
Arrangement of Public Spaces

III Policy of Financial Assistance (Four Modes of Participation)

1.Design and Construction by the Participant

In this mode, the Participant designs and develops the outdoor exhibition garden (around 1000 square meters in size) by itself, and the Organizer provides the plot of land to be used by the Participant free of charge and offers a one-off payment of 2 million RMB in subsidy. This subsidy is limited to expenses that the Participant has to incur in order to participate in the Expo Yangzhou, and shall be spent for the purposes of preparing the exhibition program, design, construction, move-in and installation, transport, operation, dismantling, and insurance. During the Expo, the Organizer grants an allowance of 250,000 RMB to the Participant, which is intended for the expenses of food and accommodation for the Participant's representatives and staff.

2.Design by the Participant

In this mode, the Participant submits the design proposal in accordance with the Organizer's basic requirements such as the theme and size of the outdoor exhibition garden, while the Organizer is responsible for the construction. After the design proposal is approved by the Preparatory Committee, the Participant shall be entitled to a one-off subsidy of 50,000 RMB if the proposal is a mere conceptual design, or to a one-off subsidy of 100,000 RMB if the proposal includes a complete set of construction drawings. During the Expo, the Organizer grants an allowance of 250,000 RMB to the Participant, which is intended for the expenses of food and accommodation for the Participant's representatives and staff.

3.Design and Construction by the Organizer with the Participant's Authorization

In this mode, the Organizer undertakes the design and construction of an outdoor exhibition garden while the Participant authorizes the Organizer in writing to name the garden after the Participant. During the Expo, the Participant may also use the exhibition garden space free of charge to organize cultural promotion activities. During the Expo, the Organizer grants an allowance of 250,000 RMB to the Participant, which is intended for the expenses of food and accommodation for the Participant's representatives and staff.

4. Participation in Indoor Exhibition

In this mode, the Organizer offers the indoor exhibition booth for free in accordance with the final exhibition layout program of the International Pavilion. The Participant shall design and set up its exhibition by itself and shall be responsible for the maintenance and operation. The Organizer may offer a certain amount to subsidize the transport. During the Expo, the Organizer grants an allowance of 250,000 RMB to the Participant, which is intended for the expenses of food and accommodation for the Participant's representatives and staff.

Transport and Accommodation Guide

I Transport Information

Yangzhou is located at the Yangtze River Delta Urban Agglomerations and Nanjing Metropolitan Circle, an area enjoying China’s most advanced economy and convenient transport. With only 300 km to Shanghai and 100km to Nanjing, Yangzhou enjoys over 10 international airports, such as Shanghai Pudong Airport, Nanjing Lukou Airport, Yangzhou-Taizhou Airport, etc. It will only take 30 minutes from Zaolinwan Tourist Resort, the Expo Site, to downtown Yangzhou, 1 hour to Nanjing, 3 hours to Shanghai, and 30 minutes to Yangzhou or Zhenjiang Railway Station.

List of Recommended Suitable Plant Species in Yangzhou

Yangzhou is situated at the Jianghuai Plain which is flat and densely covered with lakes and rivers with high groundwater level. Enjoying a pleasant subtropical humid climate, the city has four distinct seasons with the mean annual temperature of 14~15.4℃, the average January temperature of -1~1.8℃, the extreme low temperature of -8.7~-11.5℃, and an annual mean precipitation of 910~1090mm. Broad-leaved plants are dominantly seen in the city plus abundant evergreen and deciduous plants as well as flood-tolerant zonal vegetation.
