II Participation Procedure

1. Clarify Participating Intension
2. Assign Participant Representative
3. Sign Contract
4. Garden Design (Indoor Exhibition Design)
5. Garden Construction and Decoration

III Policy of Financial Assistance (Four Modes of Participation)

1.Design and Construction by the Participant

In this mode, the Participant designs and develops the outdoor exhibition garden (around 1000 square meters in size) by itself, and the Organizer provides the plot of land to be used by the Participant free of charge and offers a one-off payment of 2 million RMB in subsidy. This subsidy is limited to expenses that the Participant has to incur in order to participate in the Expo Yangzhou, and shall be spent for the purposes of preparing the exhibition program, design, construction, move-in and installation, transport, operation, dismantling, and insurance. During the Expo, the Organizer grants an allowance of 250,000 RMB to the Participant, which is intended for the expenses of food and accommodation for the Participant's representatives and staff.

2.Design by the Participant

In this mode, the Participant submits the design proposal in accordance with the Organizer's basic requirements such as the theme and size of the outdoor exhibition garden, while the Organizer is responsible for the construction. After the design proposal is approved by the Preparatory Committee, the Participant shall be entitled to a one-off subsidy of 50,000 RMB if the proposal is a mere conceptual design, or to a one-off subsidy of 100,000 RMB if the proposal includes a complete set of construction drawings. During the Expo, the Organizer grants an allowance of 250,000 RMB to the Participant, which is intended for the expenses of food and accommodation for the Participant's representatives and staff.

3.Design and Construction by the Organizer with the Participant's Authorization

In this mode, the Organizer undertakes the design and construction of an outdoor exhibition garden while the Participant authorizes the Organizer in writing to name the garden after the Participant. During the Expo, the Participant may also use the exhibition garden space free of charge to organize cultural promotion activities. During the Expo, the Organizer grants an allowance of 250,000 RMB to the Participant, which is intended for the expenses of food and accommodation for the Participant's representatives and staff.

4. Participation in Indoor Exhibition

In this mode, the Organizer offers the indoor exhibition booth for free in accordance with the final exhibition layout program of the International Pavilion. The Participant shall design and set up its exhibition by itself and shall be responsible for the maintenance and operation. The Organizer may offer a certain amount to subsidize the transport. During the Expo, the Organizer grants an allowance of 250,000 RMB to the Participant, which is intended for the expenses of food and accommodation for the Participant's representatives and staff.

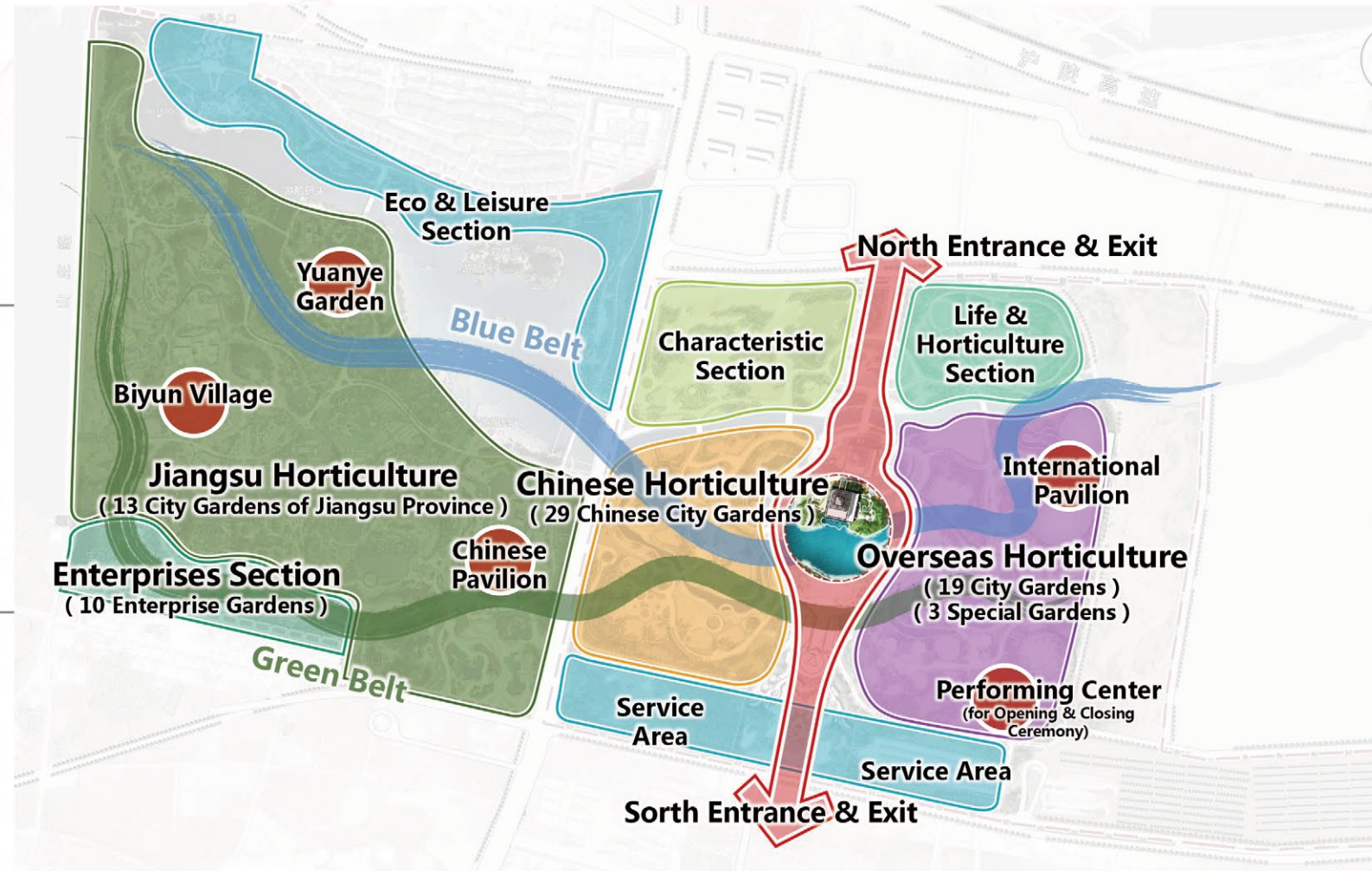

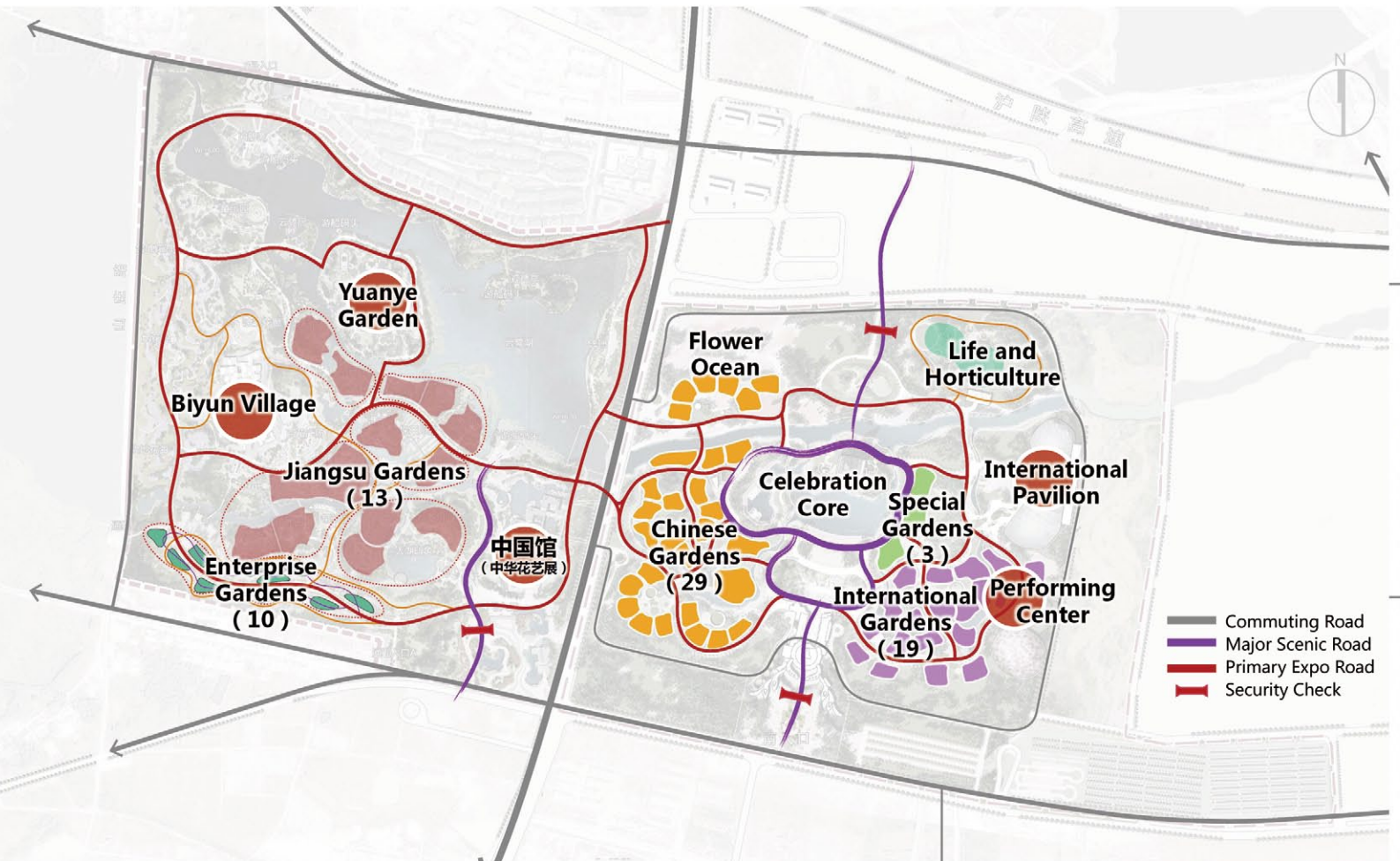

Structure: 1 axe • 2 belts • 5 areas • 8 sections

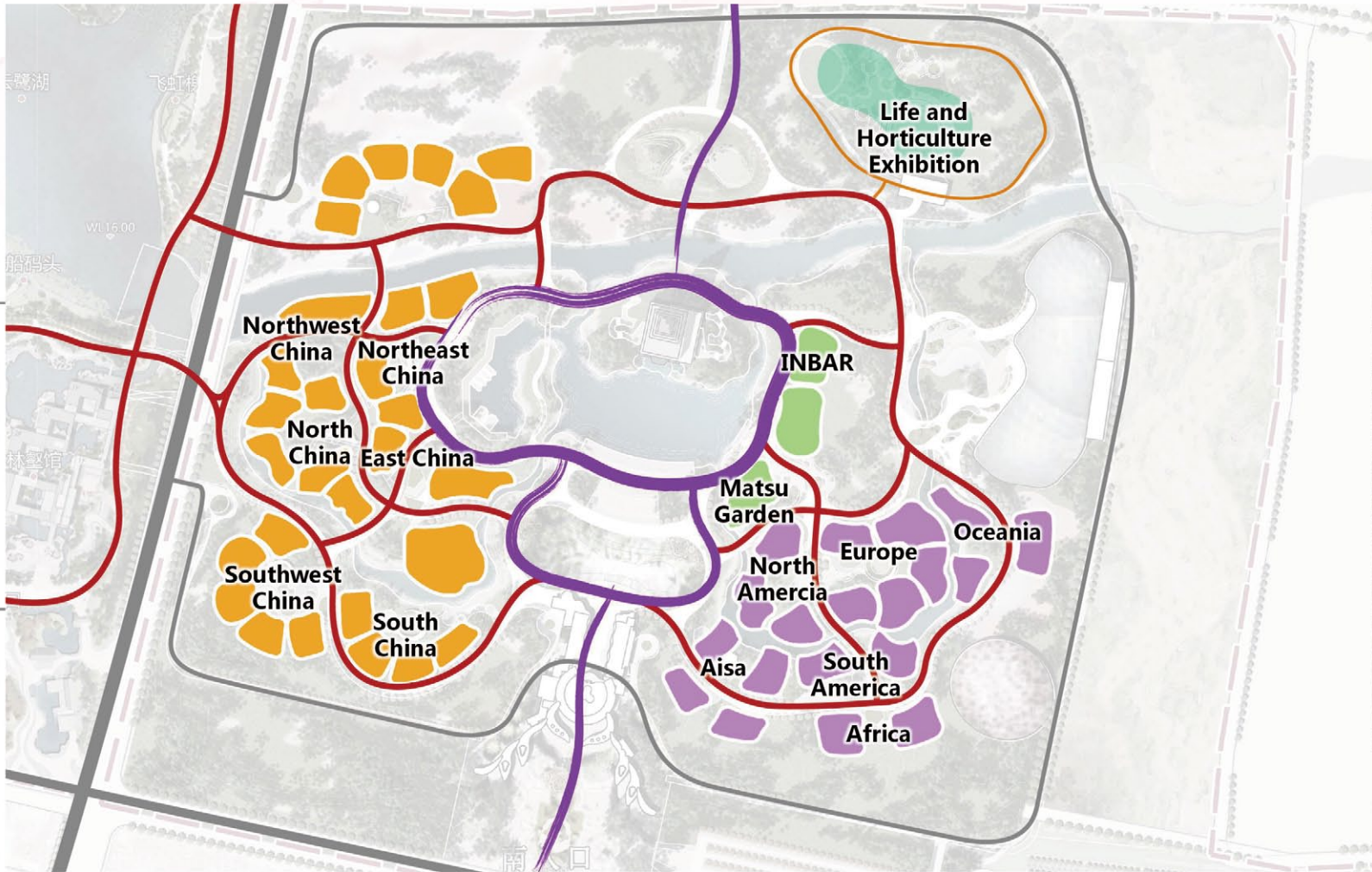


Pavilions, Gardens and Touring Route



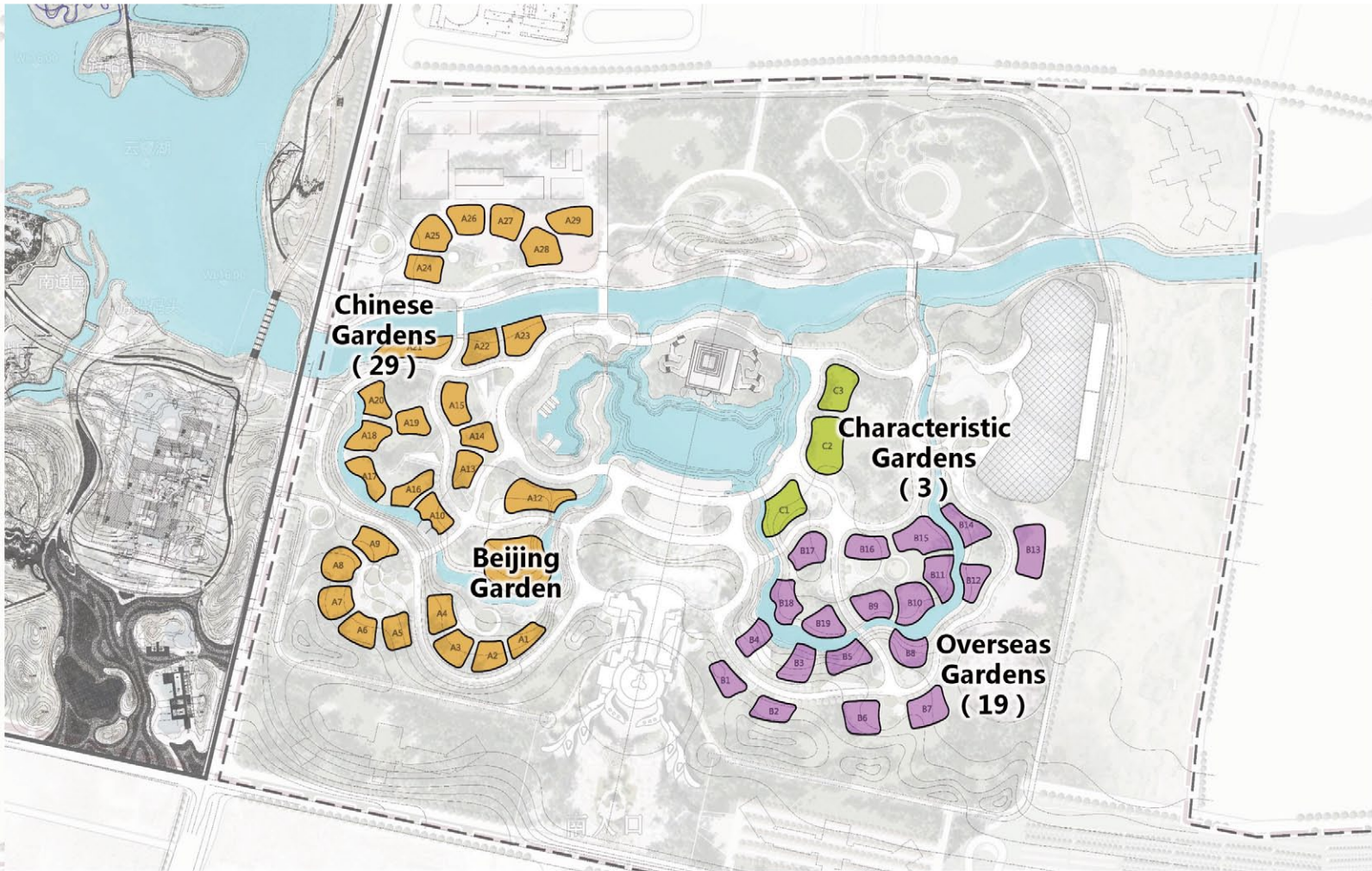
Arrangement of Public Spaces

List of Recommended Suitable Plant Species in Yangzhou

Yangzhou is situated at the Jianghuai Plain which is flat and densely covered with lakes and rivers with high groundwater level. Enjoying a pleasant subtropical humid climate, the city has four distinct seasons with the mean annual temperature of 14~15.4℃, the average January temperature of -1~1.8℃, the extreme low temperature of -8.7~-11.5℃, and an annual mean precipitation of 910~1090mm. Broad-leaved plants are dominantly seen in the city plus abundant evergreen and deciduous plants as well as flood-tolerant zonal vegetation.
