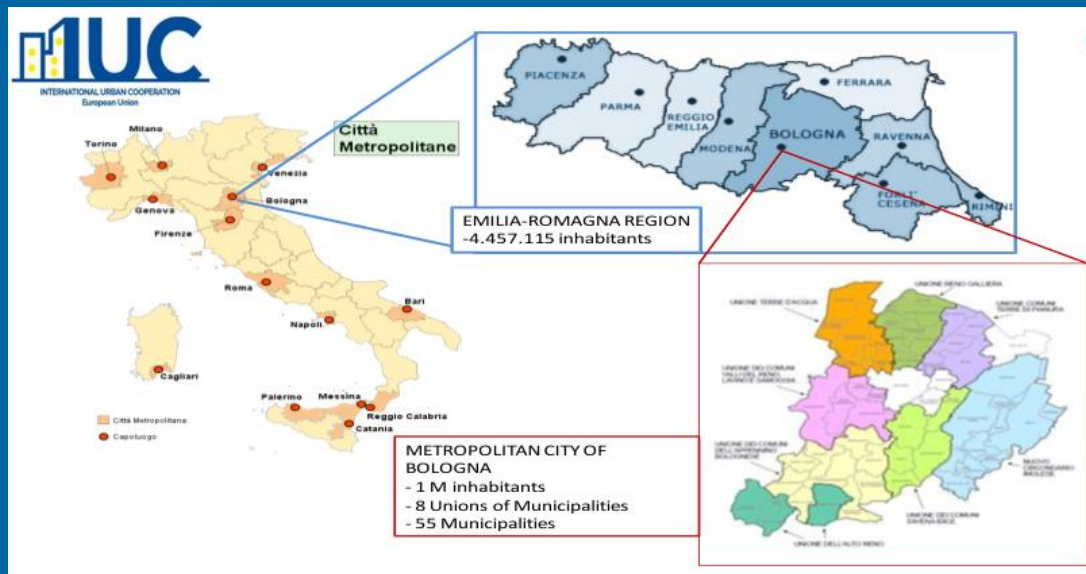

## The Cities of Panel 1 – Bologna (Italy)



Mr. Marino CAVALLO, Head of Research Innovation and EU Projects Management  
Metropolitan City of Bologna

- Bologna has 1 million inhabitants and is the capital of the Emilia Romagna region
- It is a strategic hub for freight and passengers flows
- Famous since the 17th century for its food industry and culinary arts
- Economy: motor and packing valley, industrial design, technical culture, big data & advanced manufacturing
- Bologna delegates visited China 2019 in two occasions (June & September).
- **U-CAP** focuses on industrial design & circular economy cooperation with China



## The Cities of Panel 1 – Granada (Spain)



Mr. Francisco BENITEZ, Blockchain Coordinator Granada

- Metropolitan area **500.000** inhabitants approx. and is the capital of Granada province
- UNESCO Cultural Heritage of (Alhambra y Albayzin).
- Granada was awarded the City of Science and Europe City of Sport 2019
- Granada University: Top 300 in the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) by Shanghai Ranking
- Has a very important **med-technology** innovation hub (*PTS*)
- Has received Chinese delegates visitors 2018 and visited China 2018-2019
- **UCAP** focuses on Smart City and Med-Tech Cooperation with city partners from business and research, including the Health Tech Park PTS, the digital hub OnGranada and the University of Granada.
- Has implemented a **webinar series** on the blockchain technology impact on circular economy, smart city and health (see IUC website). Will launch a bilingual platform.



## The Cities of Panel 1 – Chengdu (Sichuan)



Mr. Lang GAO, Director of Department of Innovation & Development, Sichuan Energy Internet Research Institute (EIRI), Tsinghua University

- Chengdu has 16,5 million inhabitants and is the **capital** of Sichuan province.
- The city has several economic and technological development zones.
- It has an ambitious **low carbon** work programme, including sharp carbon intensity reduction and the increase of non-fossil energy share.
- Chengdu also aims to build itself into a sustainable **smart city** as an effective way to create green GDP.
- Hosted EU cities in June 2020 and engaged in numerous online events 2020
- **UCAP** focuses on smart city and energy transition with the EIRI as the main counterpart. Planned joint research and start-up exchange on hydrogen energy.
- The EU has inaugurated two EIRI in June and October 2020.



## The Cities of Panel 1 – Yangzhou

- Yangzhou has a total area of 6,634 km<sup>2</sup> and a population of 4.6 million.
- Yangzhou is located in the middle of Jiangsu Province, connecting the north and south, the intersection of the Yangtze River and the Beijing-Hangzhou Grand Canal.
- It is the Grand Canal City in China, a “UN Habitat Award” city, and a UNESCO World Heritage List.
- Yangzhou is focusing on building an internationally acknowledged **cultural city**.
- Yangzhou visited Europe in November 2019 and it has not yet hosted EU cities.
- **UCAP** focuses on involving EU cities at the International Horticultural Exhibition (April to October 2021). It is currently building garden pavilions from Barcelona, Bologna and Rome. Also Stuttgart Region may participate in the event programme.
