On the afternoon of November 18th, the European Commission's Regional Department and the EU International Urban Cooperation Project Office held the 2020 China-Europe Regional and Urban Cooperation Online Seminar with the theme of "Green Development and Digital Transformation" in the form of a video conference. At the meeting, Deputy Director Zhang Dongqiang of the Regional Economics Department of the National Development and Reform Commission and Deputy Director General of the European Commission Normons Bomens delivered speeches respectively, and proposed further strengthening of economy and trade, technology, education, ecology, culture, etc. Specific requirements for cooperation. The Energy and Climate Action Counselor of the EU Delegation to China, representatives from Barcelona, Liuzhou, Chongqing, Yangzhou, Mannheim and other case cities, the head of the European Union's international urban cooperation projects, and experts from Peking University and Tsinghua University participated in this online seminar. The meeting also conducted work exchanges and cooperation project discussions.



According to the agenda of the meeting, Cheng Zhaojun, deputy director of the Municipal Development and Reform Commission, as a city representative of the newly included China-EU regional cooperation program in 2019, gave a speech on work experience exchange and introduced that the Municipal Development and Reform Commission and the Municipal Government Foreign Affairs Office, Housing Construction Bureau, Yangzhou University, Yizheng, Hanjiang and other places have jointly promoted the cooperation between Chinese and European cities, and promoted a number of cooperation intentions to form cooperative projects. For example, the city of Salford in the United Kingdom intends to establish a sister city relationship with Yangzhou; inviting Barcelona, Bologna, Rome, Stuttgart, etc. European cities participate in the World Horticultural Exposition and do a good job in designing the exhibition halls. Among

them, Bologna and Rome also plan to cooperate with Yangzhou University in green development and industrial design.



In the next step, the Municipal Development and Reform Commission will, in accordance with the overall arrangement of the China-EU regional policy dialogue mechanism and the work deployment of the national and provincial development and reform commissions, further strengthen cooperation with European case areas in economics, trade, industry, parks, enterprises, science and technology, education, culture, tourism, etc. The cooperation of the city will help our city expand its opening to the outside world, improve the level of internationalization of the city, and build a larger, broader, and higher-level exchange and cooperation platform.
